Northwestern Medicine Basic Nursing Assistant Training Program



A certified nursing assistant (CNA) is an allied health professional who has an important role within a healthcare team. CNAs are trained to perform essential patient care tasks delegated by licensed nursing staff.

The Northwestern Medicine Basic Nursing Assistant (BNA) Training program is a 16-week program that provides 80 hours of didactic instruction and practice in a clinical lab setting combined with 40 hours of clinical experience in an acute healthcare setting at Northwestern Memorial Hospital.

Upon program completion, students will be eligible to take the Illinois Nurse Aide Competency certification exam to become a CNA.

The BNA Program is a 16-week program held on **Fridays**

Dates: July 26 - November 15, 2024

Didactic/Classroom days: 8:00am - 5:30pm

Clinical days: 6:30am - 3:30pm
