- Must be 18 years of age.
- Submit a \$25.00 application fee (no personal checks).
- Submit the required documents - High School Diploma or GED, valid driver's license, social security card, birth certificate.
- Must pass a written math aptitude test - 70% or higher passing grade
- Applicant must seek employment. Once hired, prior to starting work, the applicant must meet with the Coordinator, present the "Letter of Intent to Hire" from the contractor stating name, address, telephone number, and social security number.
- Must take a drug screening within 48 hours or 2 working days after notification from the Apprentice Coordinator.
- Applicant must pass an in-person interview with the JATC.
- Applicant must pay a non-refundable initiation fee before beginning work.
